- Brown Middle School is **Beating the Odds**, meaning that it performs better than similar schools.

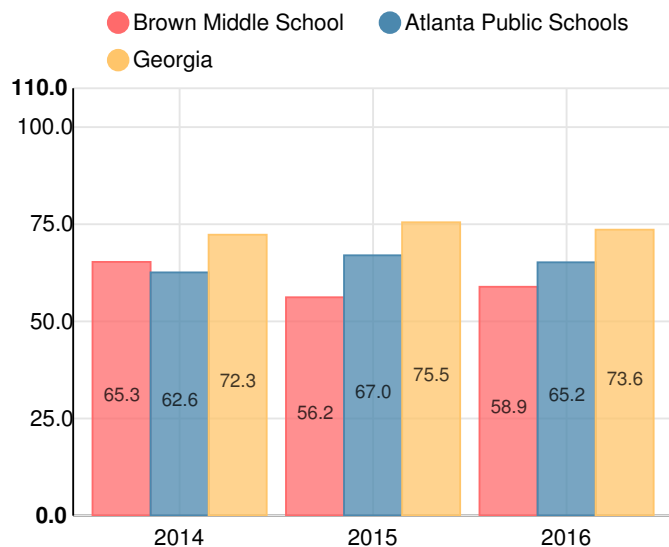

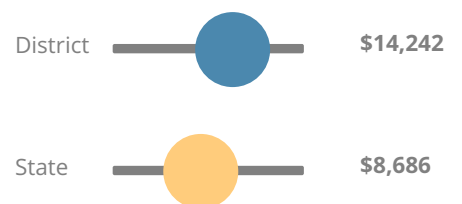

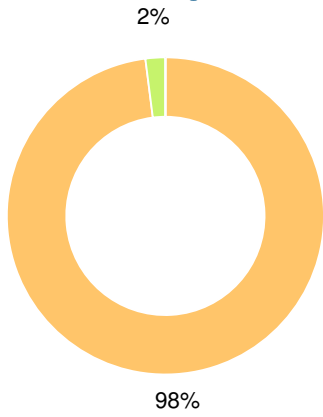

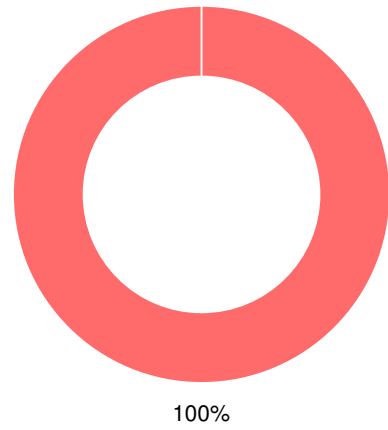

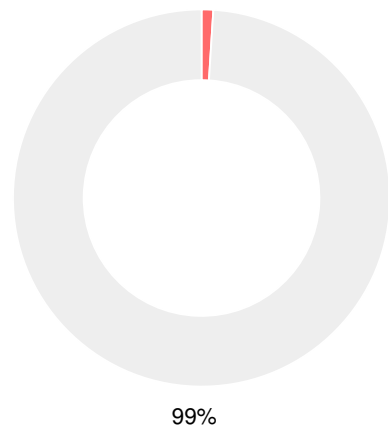

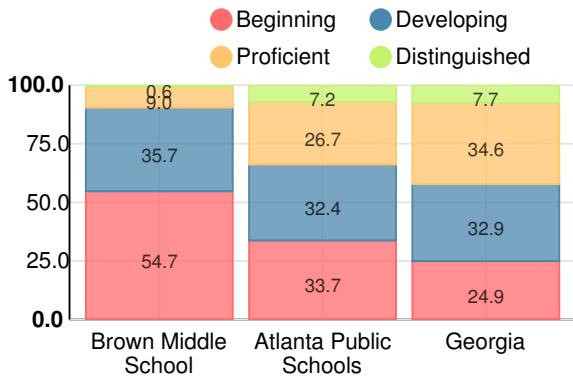

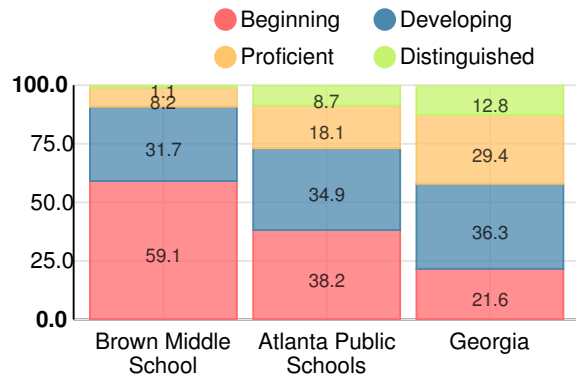

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2016 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



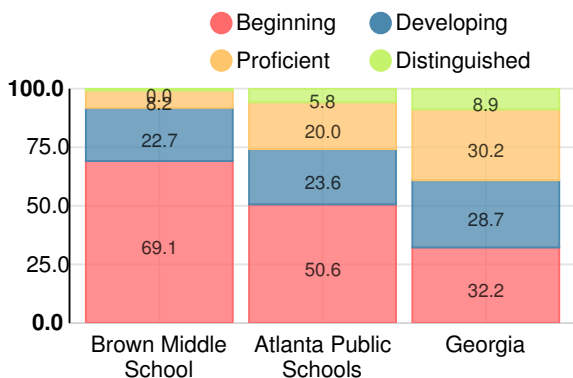

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2016 Georgia Milestones for middle school grades



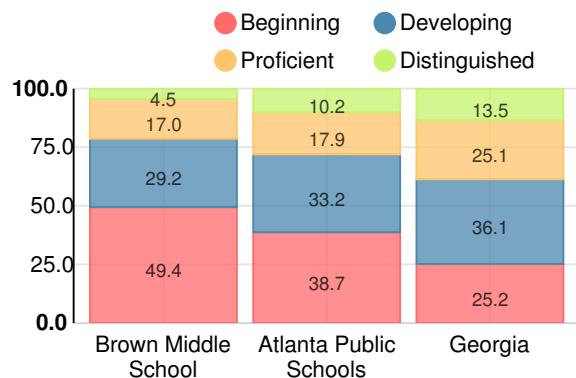
## Science
