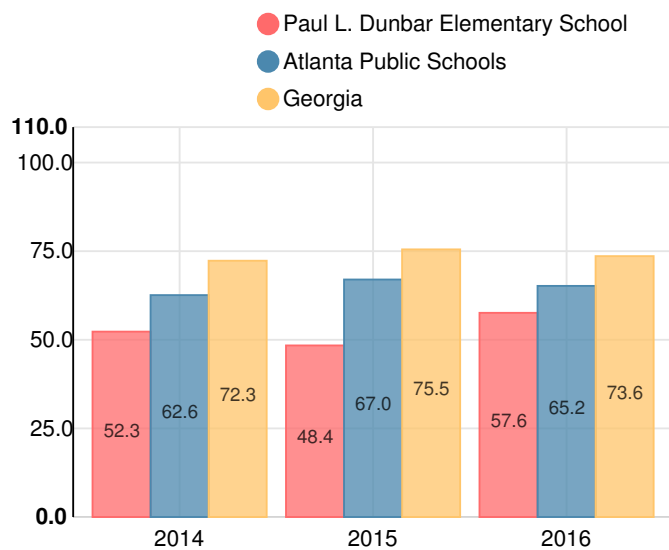

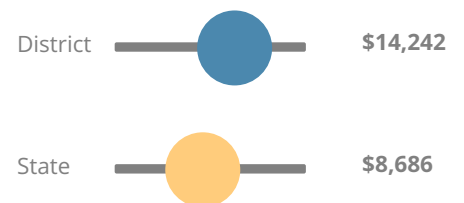

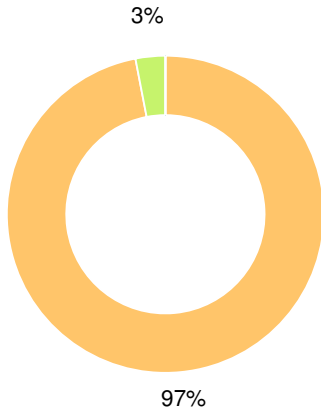


Per Pupil Expenditures



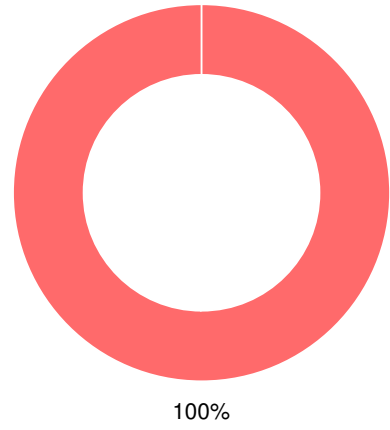

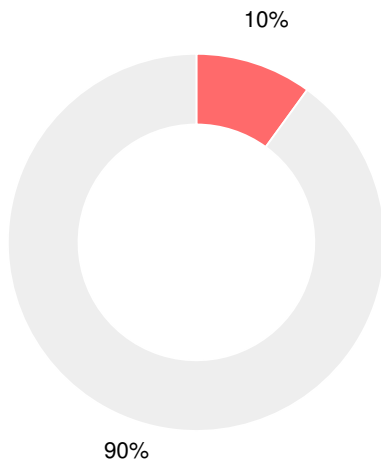

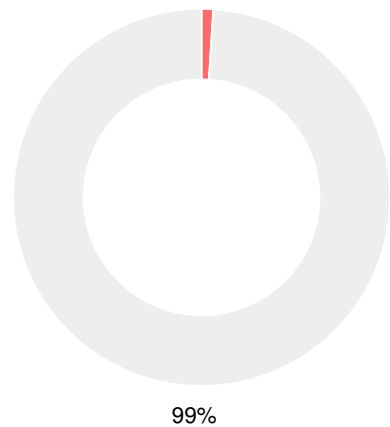

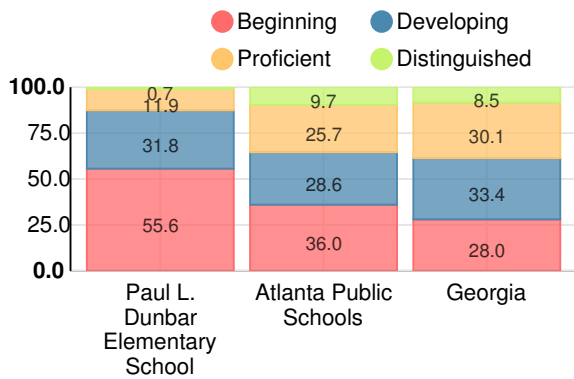

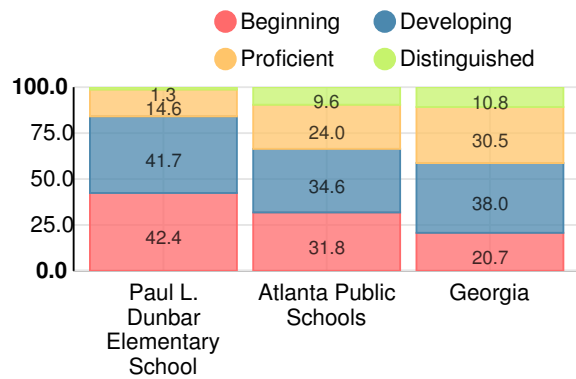

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2016 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



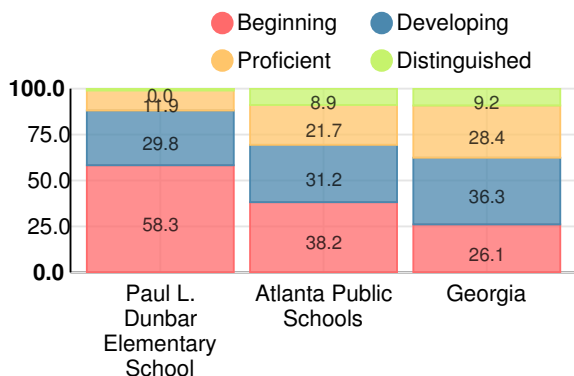

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2016 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



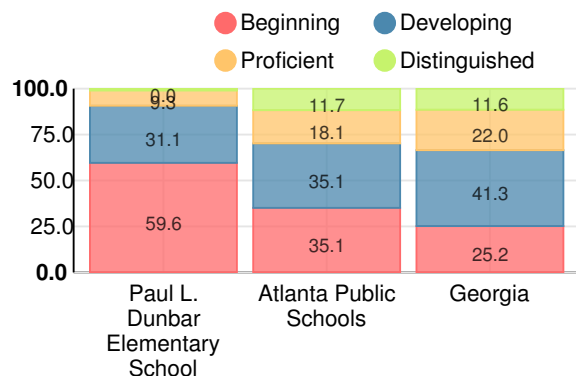

Percent of students scoring in each performance level on 2016 Georgia Milestones for elementary grades



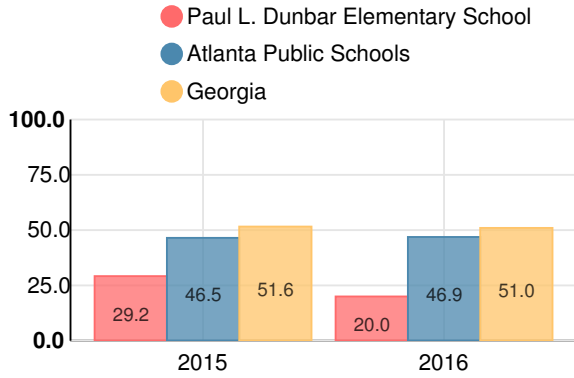
Social Studies
